Job Title: Cleaner Job Number: 021591

Job Purpose:

To undertake as part of a team, the cleaning of designated areas within the school to ensure that the building is kept in a clean and hygienic condition.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

Carrying out all cleaning work in accordance with the School's Cleaning Standards and Checklists. This will include:

- Cleaning, washing, mopping, sweeping, buffing, vacuum cleaning of all designated areas.
- Emptying rubbish bins.
- Polishing and dusting of the designated areas.
- Cleaning toilets and shower areas.
- Cleaning windows, fixtures and fittings, using where appropriate powered equipment and cleaning materials according to the agreed procedures.
- Moving furniture and equipment to assist cleaning.
- Obtaining & replenishing onsite consumables such as paper towels, toilet rolls and hand wash dispensers, or other such items as required.
- Open and lock doors as required, collecting and returning keys to Site Services Officer.
- Work in accordance with the School's Health and Safety policies, procedures and risk assessments, including COSHH (Control of Substances Hazardous to Health).
- Act in accordance with the Code of Conduct.
- Any other duties and responsibilities within the range of the salary grade.
- Undertake any training as required.
