- Assist skilled operatives with the construction and maintenance of carriageways, footways, cycleways and highway drainage systems.
- To assist with reactive maintenance including potholes and repairs to carriageways and footways.

- To assist with adjusting, replacing, and installing ironworks associated with Highway works.
- To understand and be able to assist in setting up temporary traffic management to Chapter 8.
- To learn how to use tools, plant and equipment associated with Highway works.
- To communicate and develop good working relationships with Management, Members of the Public and team members.
