Purpose of the role

As part of a team, carry out the maintenance and construction of roads, pavements and sewers.

Main Duties & Key Accountabilities

Core Knowledge

- Erect and Move Signs and Barriers in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual
- Removes, prepares, applies and compacts soils, rocks, coated and other materials to Highway, playgrounds, car parks and other associated areas
- Drive vehicles such as tandem rollers, dumper trucks, loading shovels and other vehicles associated with routine Highway maintenance including fitting and utilising simple attachments
- Use powered hand tools, plant and machinery as necessary
- Erect, fix and dismantle street furniture
- Clear snow and grit footways and pedestrian areas as directed
- To work independently in construction work including laying and raking tarmac and other flexible surfacing, lay high quality kerbing and paving such as natural stone/granite paving, setts and associated materials, laying deep drainage including pipe runs and connections, trench shoring, deep manhole construction, steel fixing, reinforced concreting, fencing and bricklaying associated with Highway work to precise levels, tolerances and exacting standards.
- Setting out work with reference to datum points supplied on drawings or by Supervisors
- Proficient in the use of recognised setting out techniques and equipment such as string lines, spirit levels, offsets and dips interpreting information supplied on drawings or from Supervisor.
- Effectively lead, supervise and motivate Roadworkers Level 1's, 2's and Apprentices in the safe delivery of high-quality services within agreed timescales, setting targets and offering guidance and support as required
- Assisting Supervisor in the cost-efficient delivery of schemes, including providing accurate data for material ordering and positive engagement with problem solving to avoid delays.
- · Operation of heavy plant or complex plant and equipment requiring specialist skills
- Ensure the delivery of service is carried out in accordance with service specifications and customer requirements, including pro-active engagement with Supervisors and Clients to resolve construction queries and complaints
- Deploy resources in team effectively to ensure priorities are met on a daily basis to ensure value for money and contribute experience and advice to customers and clients for the efficient delivery of schemes

- Engage with Supervisors and Clients in the programming of works to minimise environmental impact and maximise value for money.
- Assist Supervisors in the identification and implementation of best practise to ensure continuous improvement and innovation in service delivery.
- Deputise for Supervisors as required, including the management of material orders and client / customer liaison.
- Train and mentor junior Roadworkers and Apprentices as required, including carrying out assessments of skills progression for promotion purposes
