Job Purpose

To provide support to a classroom teacher in the planning and delivery of the curriculum and in the provision of care and welfare to a specified group of children.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. To support the class teacher at appropriate level in the delivery of the curriculum and the preparation ' of materials and equipment for classroom activities,
- 2. Participate in the provision of a full range of activities, commensurate with a child's intellectual, physical and emotional development,

 - act as carer for sick children until appropriate qualified medical assistance is available and/or until a parent or guardian collects the sick child, employees must not administer first aid, unless qualified to do so;
 - providing comfort and support to children in distress.
- 5. Assist in creating and maintaining a stimulating and attractive learning environment,
- 6. Assist with the preparation and supervision of educational visits.
- 7. Ensure as far as is reasonable, the provision of a safe, secure and healthy environment for children.
- 8. Foster links between home and school and maintain good communications with parents.
- 9. Maintain simple records as directed and contribute to the periodic assessment of children.
- 10. Contribute and participate in in-service training and staff meetings, as deemed appropriate.
- 11. Guide and assist nursery students and other trainees, unqualified staff and volunteers,
- 12. Participate in initiatives//developments within the school,
- 13. Undertake duties in the spirit of the City Council's Equal Opportunities Policy.

All employees
