- To ensure new development meets the requirements of the Council's Local Flood Risk Management Strategy, Flood Risk Assessments, and the Surface Water Management Plan and to provide technical advice to colleagues in both Flood Risk Management & Drainage and Planning Group.
- To provide drainage and flood risk advice relating to development adoptions, planning applications and for planning appeal hearings, where required.
- Ensure that the Council is able to meet its legal responsibilities in relation to Sustainable Drainage Systems on both the Highway and in the public realm including an approval process and enforcement.
- Providing Sustainable Drainage System guidance and support to developers and in particular, supporting the Council's Development Control function.
- Provide advice and support to developers for The Water Environment (Water Framework Directive) (England and Wales) Regulations 2017 compliance.
- Collate and provide data for flood risk management audit outcomes for compliance measurement.
- The supervision of development management inspector(s) to ensure compliance with design standards and policies.

- To assist colleagues and to deputise for the Flood Risk Manager by undertaking specific project work, attending meetings and participating in corporate working groups, including responding, both verbally and written, to queries from elected members, the public, contractors and statutory bodies.
