






Our Adult Social Care Team understands the difficulties adults with social care needs, their carers and families face in finding suitable day or respite opportunities.

Residential respite service

O What is on offer?

Maurice Edelman House offers respite stays for adults over 18 with learning disabilities.

The service will undertake a unique assessment process centered around supporting individual needs, interests, and choices, adapting approaches to make the person comfortable.

The respite service has five bedrooms, some with large-screen TVs, tablets, and game consoles. Some rooms also offer overhead tracking hoists and adapted bath and shower rooms.

The dedicated team treats adults with dignity and respect, promoting their independence and choices.

There are flexible date options to suit individual needs and availability.

Brandon Wood Farm

Day opportunity service



Brandon Wood Farm is a day opportunity service for adults with learning disabilities, autism and complex needs.

The farm is in a rural area and offers an abundance of tranquil outdoor space where individuals can be themselves.

The service is for individuals who cannot manage mainstream activities and may require a more bespoke day option. We support individuals from all circumstances, from those leaving school to those in their twilight years that still want to spend days outdoors.

Brandon Wood Farm offers:

- · Animal therapy with a selection of small and large breed animals
- Access a multi-sensory room when necessary or as part of a daily calming strategy
- Vegetables and plant growing in the garden and polytunnels
- Calming field walks

 Relaxing sessions in the sensory garden and listening to the aviary birds.

Multi-sensory rooms to rest in.

Sensory gardens and large spaces to listen to and see birds.

O What is on offer?

Gosford Community Hub is a day service for adults with Profound, Multiple and Learning Disabilities (PMLD).

Gosford Community Hub is near the City Centre, in the Stoke area. Their goal is to provide a high standard of care for everyone who accesses the service, promoting dignity, respect, and independence. They offer a range of activities that cater to everyone's needs, at the Hub and out in the community.

Gosford Community Hub supports people who attend with all aspects of their care, whether this be support around dysphagia, PEG feeding, personal care, thickened drinks, medication, or participation in all activities throughout the day. The aim to promote peoples' independence wherever possible, giving them an active role in the support provided. Staff plan

and run activities throughout the day in small groups, both in the Hub and the community. The Team creates meaningful and memorable days whilst providing a fun, happy, and safe environment.
