The Trust was formed in April 2015 and initially consisted of two schools: Finham Park School and Finham Park 2 School, our Free School. In April 2016, Finham Primary School joined, followed by the conversion of Lyng Hall School in July 2016 strengthening our Trust. Following a period of stabilisation, we entered a second phase of growth and were joined by Pearl Hyde Primary in January 2019 and most recently in January 2021, Lillington Primary and Whitley Academy. We currently aim to be a 9 school Trust within the next few years.

With around 5,600 students, 700 staff and a highly effective operating model, Finham Park Multi Academy Trust gives member schools the financial and operational strength to drive school improvement and provides increased opportunities for students and staff across the Trust.



What do we offer to schools?

Joining Finham Park Multi Academy Trust has opened up a wealth of opportunity for our schools. Our Trust is built on a reputation of delivering educational excellence over many years. We are dedicated to working with all our School Leaders to co-construct experiences that lead to all our young people being part of a "World Class" education over time. For example, our Head teachers work together in a Strategic Operations Group where all contribute toward the strategic direction and operations of our Trust. The breadth of school contexts within Finham Park Multi Academy Trust also adds huge value when we support one another to tackle the challenges faced by all schools in the changing educational environment in the UK.

Facilities Development

Our Facilities Management team work with our schools to ensure their environment is both maintained to a high standard and also benefits from further development over time. Finham Park Multi Academy Trust schools benefit from a huge range of specialist facilities across the group and we have enjoyed considerable success in working with partners to secure additional funding, for example from the Education Funding Agency's Condition Improvement Fund (CIF); this has supported boiler replacement; roof replacement and toilet refurbishment over the last year.

Human Resources Management

Our highly qualified team of Human Resources professionals are dedicated to ensuring staff are supported. We offer a full service of Human Resources support for all our schools.



Information Technology Support

Our Multi Academy Trust Information Technology (IT) Services Team offer a full range of services from strategic and technical advice to operational support and a dedicated 'Helpdesk'. Finham Park Multi Academy Trust schools utilise the FROG Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) platform to support our interschool co-construction activity. These exciting curriculum developments, led by subject specialists from all schools are transforming our approach to sharing pedagogical practice, improving the education for our pupils and reducing workload for teachers.

The City

Coventry is an historic city dating back to Saxon and Roman settlements as well as developing significantly during medieval times, and has a proud history in weaving, watchmaking, cycle manufacture and the automotive and engineering industries. Following devastating bombing during World War II, the city became a symbol of hope and regeneration and was the first city to 'twin' with another city in the world – the city is now twinned with 27 other towns and cities internationally. This also paved the way for the city to become a centre for peace and reconciliation and at its heart is the modern Cathedral designed by Sir Basil Spence, right next to the University campus.

More recently, the city has enjoyed taking part in the Olympic Games, hosting international football matches at its Ricoh Arena; and artists and performers in the city created the incredible 6 metre cycle-powered Lady Godiva puppet which travelled to London to take part in the Olympic opening Ceremony. Coventry is very proud to be the UK City of Culture in 2021 – exciting times! The region has a diverse range of activities to enjoy, including major pop concerts, ice hockey, rugby, football, theatre and has some interesting local attractions including the British Road Transport Museum, Herbert Art Gallery and Museum and a wide range of restaurants and cafes.

Coventry enjoys excellent public transport links and close proximity to major road networks – London is just under one hour by train and the city is easily connected to the surrounding countryside of Warwickshire. Kenilworth, Leamington Spa and Warwick are all within commutable distance of the school from the South, while Solihull and Birmingham lie to the East.

Easy commuting to Coventry means that you will have a wide choice of areas to consider living if you need to relocate to join our team - there is the city itself with many multicultural suburbs, thriving towns and villages located in beautiful nearby countryside.
